- Deadlines: (For individuals submitting items for the store)
 - **Oct. 15th – submission of an item to make the Live Auction.** Item will need to be delivered to the church office by Oct. 21st, so a list can be published for the Live Auction. Pictures will be posted on the church Facebook page and viewed on Oct 21st and 28th.
 - **Oct. 25th – submission of non-perishable items to make the Silent Auction or Get-It-Now Shop.** Pictures will be posted on the church Facebook page and viewed on Oct 28th.
 - **Nov. 3rd – 8:30 a.m. fresh baked/perishable items.** These items can be delivered the morning of the event.
- If you would like to bring items to the church as you prepare them, we are collecting them in the church office and placing them in a secure location. The office is open M-Th from 9 am-12 noon & 1-4 pm.
- The anticipated schedule for Nov. 3, 2018 is as follows:
 - 8:00 a.m. Early crew arrives and gets ready to open
 - **9:00 a.m. Fellowship Hall will open.** Persons who wish to participate in the live auction or silent auction will need to register to get a number. People can view the live auction items, participate in the silent auction area, or visit the Get-It-Now Shop.
 - **9:00 – 9:55 a.m. Viewing the Live Auction items; Participating in Silent Auction; Shopping in the Get-It-Now Store.** The Silent Auction will end at 9:55 a.m.
 - **10:00 – 11:00 a.m. The Live Auction**
