Liturgist: Let us each think of a moment when someone that you least expected to see suddenly stands before you. A moment when something you'd lost is found again and you can scarcely believe your eyes. Think of a moment when your fear was suddenly proved unfounded and you were surprised by joy.

People: This morning is such a moment. We resign ourselves for the worst, and suddenly life turns around for the good.

Liturgist: We come this Easter morning, to be shaken from our conviction that nothing can change our situation. We come feeling overwhelmed by the world's chaos, disillusioned by its politics and hollow promises.
